



POLICY FOR RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL OF RUBBISH

“The earth is the Lord’s and everything in it” (Psalm 24:1)

Totterdown Baptist Church have agreed the following policy on rubbish disposal and recycling. Copies are to be given to all users of the church building, including private hirers. It is a condition of hire that all users adhere to this policy.

- All resources should be used carefully and responsibly to avoid unnecessary waste.
- All possible metal, plastic, paper, glass and cardboard should be separated and placed in the labelled containers, which are emptied weekly. A can crusher is provided for drink cans.
- Food waste must be placed in the food bin, which should always be lined with newspaper. A supply of newspaper will be kept behind the food bin.
- The cleaner will check the fridge weekly and any out of date food will be disposed of.
- Black bags must **NEVER** be left beside dustbins and bin lids **MUST** be fully closed, or SITA will not empty the bins.
- If larger quantities of rubbish are generated on occasions, it is the responsibility of the user to dispose of extra bags.
- If occasional hirers produce more than one bag of rubbish from their event they should dispose of the extra bags themselves.
- Soiled disposable nappies must **NEVER** be left in bins on tbc premises, or in tbc black dustbins. It is the responsibility of parents/carers to dispose of their own nappies.
